## Vineyard

The Lolita Vineyard is a special place, owned and farmed by Pam and Lee Martinelli Jr., planted to clone 777 on 420 A Mgt rootstock on Yorkville Clay Loam soils. It's a sweet, little block planted to a south facing hillside and meticulously cared for to attain true vine balance.

## Vintage

The 2019 vintage was cooler overall with some rain in May which delayed the ripening process a bit and allowed for a later harvest time period. Crop size was average to slightly above average for Russian River Valley Pinot Noir, which was a blessing following the larger 2018 vintage

## Tasting Notes

This rose is made via the saignee process wherein free run wine is bled from the tank to produce a very bright style of rose with plenty of ripe strawberry, raspberry and punchy acidity. Pairs well with seafood, brunch, sunny days and watching sunsets. Drink now through 2022.
