Vintage

The 2021 vintage was highlighted by a profound drought in California which exhibited as lower vigor and an earlier growing season and harvest. Winegrape yields were down anywhere from 10-50% depending on the varietal and appellation, which was tough on growers but resulted in extremely high quality wines. Flavor development came on early and allowed us to pick each vineyard as soon as the acid profiles and Brix were in range, which yielded well-balanced wines with intense expression.

About Nalu

Nalu (the Hawaiian word for wave) is an homage to the Hawaiian culture and our love for the ocean. Every growing season in the vineyard is like surfing your favorite break; stay in front of the wave and go with the flow. This wine was fermented in stainless steel tanks to preserve the beautiful pineapple, passionfruit and pomelo notes that remind us of time at the beach with our Ohana. The bright citrus acidity and guava flavors make this wine an easy quaffer in the sunshine, or the perfect complement to your favorite Hawaiian and Asian dishes. The screwcap makes this tropical beauty even more accessible to enjoy and share with aloha.

This vintage of Nalu sports aromatics of fresh cut pineapple, pomelo, lemon crème cookie and minerality with bright pineapple and lilikoi acidity, juicy citrus fruit middle with a lengthy finish.
