Vintage

The 2021 vintage was highlighted by a profound drought in California which exhibited as lower vigor and an earlier growing season and harvest. Winegrape yields were down anywhere from 10-50% depending on the varietal and appellation, which was tough on growers but resulted in extremely high quality wines. Flavor development came on early and allowed us to pick each vineyard as soon as the acid profiles and Brix were in range, which yielded well- balanced wines with intense expression.

Tasting Notes

Aromatics and flavors of lychee, white flower, and fresh pear with beautiful weight, depth, and texture due to the barrel fermentation in neutral, French oak.
